**MIXING INSTRUCTIONS:**

Pour the required amount of oil into the water in the mixing tank and agitate well. Maintain continuous agitation while spraying. Only mix sufficient spray solution for immediate use and avoid storing.

**PROTECTION OF LIVESTOCK, FISH, CRUSTACEANS AND ENVIRONMENT:**

Do not contaminate streams rivers or waterways with the chemical or used container.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:**

Store in closed, original container in a cool, well-ventilated area. Do not store for prolonged periods in direct sunlight.

Triple or preferably pressure rinse containers before disposal. Add rinsings to spray tank. Do not dispose of undiluted chemicals on site. If recycling, replace cap and return clean container to recycler or designated collection point.

If not recycling, break, crush or puncture and bury empty containers in a local authority landfill. If no landfill is available, bury the containers below 500 mm in a disposal pit specifically marked and set up for this purpose clear of waterways, desirable vegetation and tree roots. Empty containers and product should not be burnt.

All 1000 L containers remain the property of SACOA Pty Ltd. Empty contents fully into application equipment. Close all valves and return to point of supply for refill or storage.
