### GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

SACOA XSEED Spray Oil is an emulsifiable vegetable oil and is suitable for use with herbicides, insecticides and fungicides. It increases herbicide activity by better wetting and absorption and improve spray coverage.

### MIXING INSTRUCTIONS

SACOA XSEED Spray Oil mixes quickly and easily with water and should be added directly to the spray tank after the addition of pesticide. It should not be added direct to undiluted sprays containing wetting agent.

### PRECAUTION

Follow the safety directions of the agricultural chemical this product is to be mixed with.

### COMPATIBILITY

SACOA XSEED Spray Oil is suitable for use with most herbicides, defoliant, insecticides and fungicides. Always check the label of the product to be mixed with SACOA XSEED Spray Oil before use.

### CROP SAFETY

Mixtures of SACOA XSEED Spray Oil with other plant protection products should be tested on a small area prior to large scale use.

### PROTECTION OF LIVESTOCK, WILDLIFE, FISH, CRUSTACEANS AND ENVIRONMENT

Do not contaminate streams, rivers or waterways with chemical or used container.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Keep out of Reach of Children. Store in the closed original container in a well ventilated area, as cool as possible. Do not store for prolonged periods in direct sunlight. Triple or (preferably) pressure rinse containers before disposal. Add rinsings to spray tank. Do not dispose of undiluted chemicals on site. If recycling, replace cap and return clean container to recycler or designated collection point. If not recycling, break, crush, puncture or bury empty containers in a local authority landfill. If not available, bury the container below 500mm in a disposal pit specifically marked and set up for this purpose clear of waterways, desirable vegetation and tree roots. Empty containers and product should not be burnt. All 1000L containers remain the property of SACOA Pty Ltd. Empty contents fully into application equipment. Close all valves and return to point of supply for refill or storage.
